Declaration

Brechel Electronic – Industrial Interface Solutions declares under its sole responsibility that the products identified above comply with the substance restrictions of Directive 2011/65/EU of the European Parliament and of the Council on the restriction of the use of certain hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment (RoHS), including the amendment of Annex II by Commission Delegated Directive (EU) 2015/863 and subsequent applicable amendments.

Applicable exemptions

Where applicable, exemptions listed in Annex III to Directive 2011/65/EU may be used as documented in the manufacturer's technical documentation. Each exemption is applied only to components and applications that fall within its legal scope and for which corresponding supplier or technical documentation is retained.

Basis of assessment

The conformity assessment is based on the manufacturer's technical documentation, including supplier declarations, material declarations and/or test reports, as applicable. Documentation is maintained following the principles of EN IEC 63000:2018, *Technical documentation for the assessment of electrical and electronic products with respect to the restriction of hazardous substances*.

This declaration remains valid only while the product composition and the applicable legal requirements remain unchanged. RoHS exemptions are time-limited and subject to review; their continued

validity is monitored by the manufacturer.

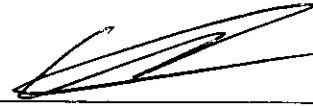
